




INTRODUCTION

 We are Members of the National Alumni Association of Lab/Tubman High school in the Americas and graduates of William V.S. Tubman High School.



we continue to generate on the average \$10,000.00 each year gross for every convention. We need to improve on our funds raising





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



Leadership Award


Pastor Motuba Isreal Harding Leadership Award

The Project 2015 Committee will facilitate the suave planning and implementation of activities with specific role and responsibilities to each subcommittee.


WHEN
